



Answer and Explanation: Synthesis means "to make" in biology. There are many examples of important synthesis reactions. During DNA synthesis, a new molecule of DNA is made so that the resulting products are two identical DNA molecules. During protein synthesis, new proteins are made according to the mRNA transcript.




